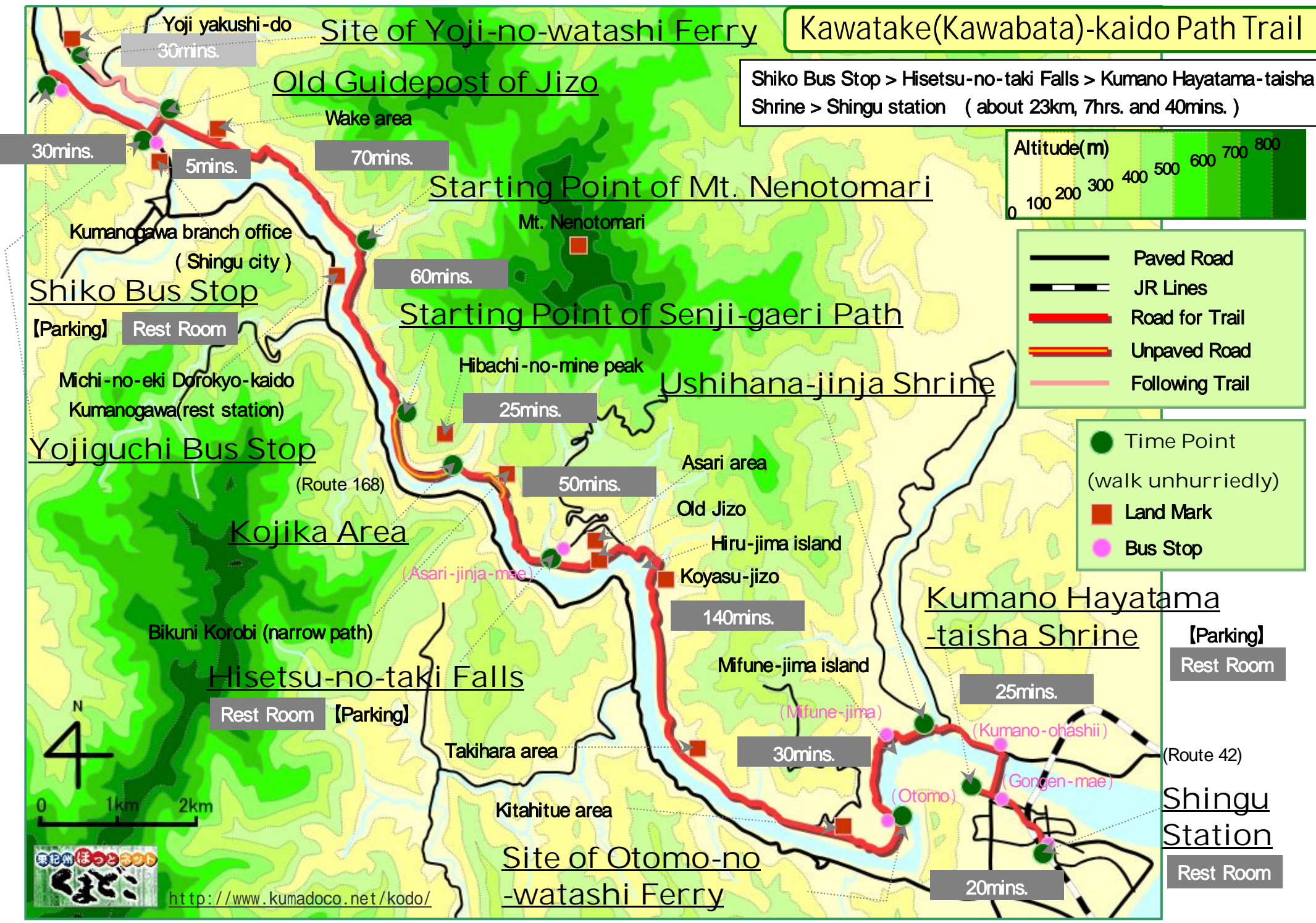


Kawatake(Kawabata)-kaido Path Trail
